**2009 REGIONAL Pistol Match with Leg and Distinguished
Revolver Matches
June 20 and 21, 2009**

Match Officials:

Match Director: Dianne Adamowski

Chief Range Officer: John Gunn, Jr.

Chief Statistical Officer: Dennis Timony

Eligibility: Open to any member of the National Rifle Association (this is a club requirement). Teams will consist of four firing members, one alternate, a captain and/or coach and will represent either a club affiliated with NRA (Rule 2.11 or (A) (B)) a law enforcement agency (Rule 2.14), a regular service or reserve unit (including National Guard) (Rule 2.13). The Team Captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team. State Association Teams may enter the team matches (Rule 2.12). Pick-up teams are not allowed (Rule 2.10). Match Officials may not compete. Entry will be allowed upon presentation of NRA number. Juniors who are not NRA members must show their membership in an affiliated club on the registration form.

Match Conditions: NRA Pistol Rules and classifications govern. Shooters score. Classification determined by NRA Card or temporary book (Rule 19.6). Those without a valid classification will fire in the Master Class. Shooters should furnish staple gun and clipboard. Ten minute break between .22 Caliber Aggregate and Centerfire Matches. One hour break for lunch following Centerfire Aggregate. Souvenir award issued to each competitor.

Match Schedule: One relay each day, starting precisely at 9:00 a.m.. Competitors should report to the range a minimum of fifteen minutes early.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See NRA Rule 16 for procedure.

Entries: Entries in individual events will be made by using the attached registration voucher accompanied by a check or money order payable to Dennis Timony in the amount commensurate with the matches to be entered. Entries Limited: Thirty per day.

Fees: Full 2700 match - \$40.00; two guns - \$35.00; one gun -\$ 20.00. DCM match -\$10.00. Distinguished Revolver -\$5.00. Team per gun fired- \$35.00.

Team Matches: will be fired at the conclusion of the individual matches and DCM and Distinguished Revolver Match.

Entries close: June 19, 2007. Following closing, post entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until range limit is reached. Team matches close at 9:00 a.m. on the first day of the match.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets will be available from the Statistician on the morning of the match. NRA membership cards and classification cards must be exhibited before issue of Squadding tickets. Squadding information for Team Matches will be announced on the range. A competitor who fails to obtain his Squadding tickets or who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in the event.

Awards: Individual awards will be based upon a return of entry fees to the competitors in the form of cash awards. There must be at least four (4) competitors in a class to qualify for an award. There will be one additional award for each additional five competitors in a class. A class that does not have the minimum number of competitors will be combined upwards until there is a minimum number. If there are less than four High Masters, they will be eligible for the open award only.

Team Match awards will be based upon a return of entry fees to the teams in the form of cash awards. There must be at least four teams in a class to qualify for an award. In an absence of the minimum number of teams in a classification, then the teams will be combined upwards until there is a minimum number. There must be a minimum of four teams to merit any award in the team matches.

First, second and third place open awards in the Regional Championship and first place awards in the Team Matches are provided by the NRA.

Match Schedule: Competitors will fire the aggregate on one day. That day must be designated at the time of registration. The DCM match and the Revolver Distinguished Match may be fired on the other day.

Match 16 is the Grand Aggregate.

Use of alcohol before or during match is forbidden and will result in offenders expulsion and forfeiture of all fees.

Directions to Range: **From the North;** Travel south on the NJ Turnpike and exit at interchange 4. Proceed to Route 295, travel south on Route 295 to Route 561 marked Haddonfield Gibbsboro (Exit 32), go towards Gibbsboro, travel past the shopping center complex and take a right at the traffic light at Clementon/Gibbsboro Road. Proceed approximately ½ mile. The club will be on the left side of the road, just beyond the lake.

From the South: Take Route 295 to Route 561 (EXIT 32) and follow directions listed above on Route 561 to the club.

From the West: Cross the Walt Whitman Bridge to Route 295 North: head towards Trenton. Exit at Route 561 (Exit 32) marked Haddonfield-Gibbsboro and follow directions listed above from that point.
